

Hometown Civitan Club, Inc. (HCC) was founded as an all-women's club in 2015. It is a dues based, 501(c)(4) organization and part of Civitan International (CI), which is a 501(c)(3). A portion of the dues goes to CI, supporting a number of charitable efforts including the Civitan International Research Center, a world leader in the research and treatment of Intellectual and Developmental Diseases (IDD). HCC's focus is on IDD and underserved women and children in the local communities of Sumter, Lake and Marion counties.

Over the years, members have donated countless volunteer hours for local charities and causes in addition to over \$90,000 in cash grants. Twenty-four charities have benefited from this support. Several charities have benefited from club members for their fundraising activities and support as active charity board members.

Funds have been raised from hosting social events, golf tournaments (2015 & 2016) and by participating in the Sumter County Adopt-a-Precinct program (2018, 2020, 2022 & 2024), where volunteer poll workers donate their wages to the club.

In 2024, HCC decided to expand its fundraising capabilities to provide a greater impact for our constituents. We founded a fundraising wing in the form of Hometown Charities, Inc. (HCI), which is a 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to raising funds to support charities in Central Florida.

The general membership meets on a monthly basis. Each meeting has a speaker, most often from a local charity aligned with the specific interests of the club members. Often visits/events are held at the charities that received grants in the current year. Separate, purely social gatherings are held each year.

The club has been blessed with strong and dedicated leadership over the decade of service with Presidents Betty Rohan (founder, 2 years), Penny Badolato, Karen Schwering, Babe Rogers, Mary Anderson (2 years), Laura McLaughlin and Judi Higbee (2 years).

The club has received a number of awards including Cl Outstanding New Club (2015), District Civitan of the Year - Betty Rohan (2015), Villages Homeowner Advocates "Volunteer Club of the Year" (2020) and Outstanding District Club (2022), as well as many Honor Club awards from Civitan International.
